



# CHEMZYME PLUS

## Enzyme Based Cleaner for Hard and Soft Surfaces

**Chemzyme Plus** is a blend of bacteria together with surface active agents which is designed to clean hard surfaces. The surfactants provide wetting and help lift the soils and the bacteria digest much of the dirt and grease. Chemzyme Plus is supplied as a concentrate and should be used diluted at up to 50 to 1 with water.

Chemzyme Plus is an environmentally friendly cleaner :

- Concentrated Product – therefore reduced packaging and less water transported
- Biodegradable Surface Active Agents – therefore no problems with waste cleaning solutions
- Enzyme producing bacteria - eliminates grease and long chain organic molecules

### Method of Use for hard surfaces.

For floors, dilute Chemzyme Plus at 50 : 1 with water and damp mop over the floor. There is no need to rinse and the Chemzyme Plus will continue to digest dirt and grease as the floor dries.

For other hard surfaces use Chemzyme Plus at 50 to 1 in a bucket for swabbing or at 10 to 1 in a trigger sprayer and spray on wipe off.

### Areas of use

Hotels, health clubs, sports centres, , halls of residence.

**Chemzyme Plus** is also used on carpets, floorboards, and soft furnishings to combat the smell of urine and other soiling, particularly in residential care homes. It acts quickly to eliminate foul smells and works organically to remove any waste matter in the carpet pile.

- Instant de-odorising while the biological action takes place.
- Organically eliminates body fluids and waste.
- Enzymatic action, using naturally occurring bacteria.

### Method of Use for Carpets and Upholstery

Remove as much heavy soiling as possible.

Spray Chemzyme Plus over the surface, ensuring that complete wetting has taken place. Soiled area must be kept damp. (Bacteria require a minimum of 15% moisture to work). "If the surface dries the action dies". Leave for at least one hour to allow action to take place; heavier soiling may require a longer period.

Allow to dry and either vacuum or brush deposits away
